Dr. Davis is the associate director for medical specialties and director of cardiology services at the UTMB Electronic Health Network (EHN). Dr. Davis is engaged in the integration of digital peripheral devices in the diagnosis and treatment of cardiovascular disorders using the EHN/Digital Medical Services® telemedicine platform, and in the application of telemedicine and the electronic medical record to treat and manage chronic disease, with a special emphasis on heart failure.

Previous to his current position he served as director of cardiology for Digital Medical Services®, UTMB Correctional Managed Care. Before that, he was a faculty member in the division of cardiology at UTMB from 1988 through 1997. Prior to UTMB, he was a member of the faculty at Stanford University School of Medicine in the division of cardiology in 1988.

Dr. Davis also holds a clinical faculty appointment at the University of Texas Health Sciences Center at Houston. He is board certified in Internal Medicine and in Cardiovascular Disease, and is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology. Dr. Davis is the recipient of the Internal Medicine Faculty Physician of the Year Award at UTMB in 1990, and he received the University of Texas Health Sciences Center at Houston Cardiology Fellowship Teaching Award in 1999 and 2005.

Dr. Davis is a member of the board of directors of United Cerebral Palsy of Greater Houston and also serves on its executive committee. In addition, Dr. Davis serves on the American Telemedicine Association's Business and Finance SIG Program Planning Committee.
