Dr. Boultinghouse currently serves as the associate director and chief medical officer for UTMB's Electronic Health Network. He was formerly the director of operations and medical director for UTMB's Center for Telehealth.

During the past five years, Dr. Boultinghouse has been a central figure in the development and deployment of a telehealth network that supports both telemedicine and multiple integrated health information systems. This telehealth system, collectively known as Digital Medical Services® (DMS®), will be responsible for more than 60,000 telehealth encounters this year.

Dr. Boultinghouse is a recognized authority in the use of telemedicine in extremely remote environments and in disaster support. Formally the director of UTMB's Life Flight Operation, he currently serves as the medical director of National Disaster Medical System Texas-3 Disaster Medical Assistance Team.

Dr. Boultinghouse is a board certified Emergency Medicine Specialist and is currently pursuing a master's degree from Harvard's School of Public Health.
